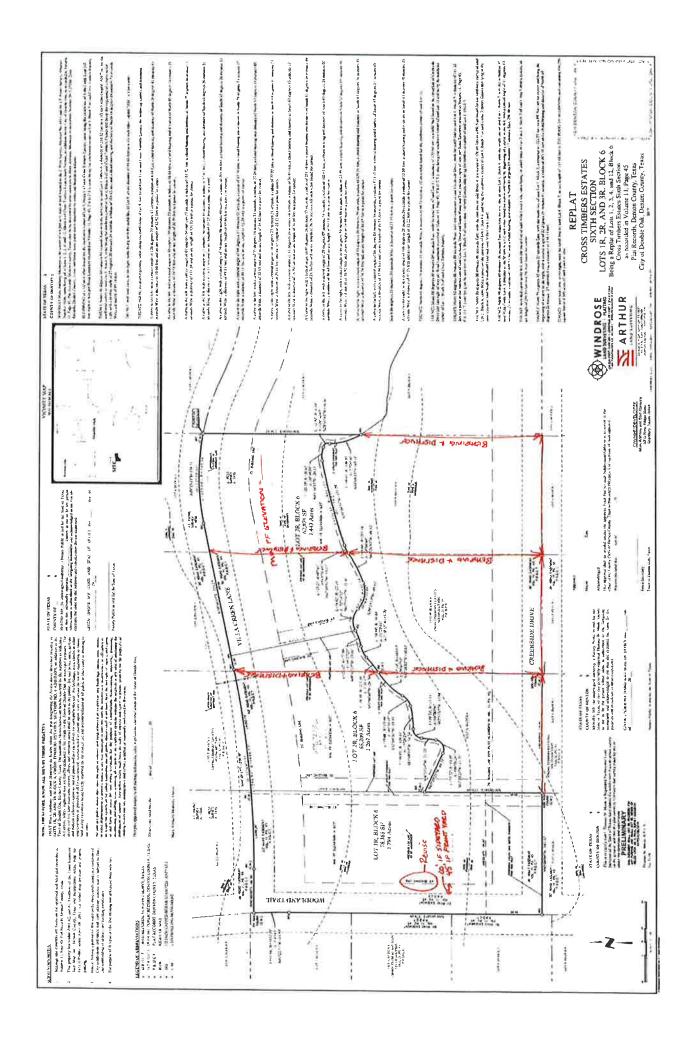

Halff Associates does not recommend approval of the Replat of Cross Timbers Estates, Sixth Section. Please note the following:

- 1. Include Lots 9, 10, and 11 of Block 6 in the Replat and provide all bearings and distances of these parcels, including the existing Lots 2, 3, and 4. This will better establish and verify the southern property line between the lots.
- 2. Provide lowest floor elevation for each lot 3R.
- 3. The current replat shows a 45-foot setback from the centerline, providing a net setback from road easement of 15 foot. Please revise and show appropriate setback as per Town Ordinance 10-4. The building setback along Woodland Trail (Lot 1R) is to be:
 - a. Side yard: Setback of at least 20 feet from the property line or road easement, whichever is the closest.
 - Front Yard: Minimum depth from edge of road easement to front of Principal Building 45 feet.
