

- Increase presence of patrol cars throughout town
- Authorize overtime for additional patrol
- Recruit/Hire police officer
- Consider mobile speed detector sign
- Consider digital display speed signs on specific roads
- Addition of city-wide signs to speed signposts
- Rumble strips/speed bumps



Speed Control Measure Options

DOPD Traffic study and recommendations:

- Stationary Post Speed Limit Signs:
- Kings East and West ends and midway 2 additional signs
- Simmons North and South Ends 2 additional signs
- Waketon West of Chinn Chapel 1 additional sign
- Cedar Crest, South of 407 1 additional sign
- Points of entrance to town (City Wide Speed Limit)-10 supplemental signs
- Speed Limit Trailer Sign:
- Mobility allows it to be moved and parked in different areas of time (respectful of homeowners and mindful of terrain/visibility)
- Versatility allows for targeted time frames and length of time in an area
- Can produce traffic analysis reports
- Supplemental City-wide Signs:
- Add to current posted speed limits at entrances to town for reminder of city-wide speed limit




Alternative Solutions
