Basic Services and Schedule

Waste collection

EVERY FRIDAY – REPUBLIC SERVICES BLUE POLYCART And up to 15 bags of yard waste.

Recycling

EVERY FRIDAY - REPUBLIC SERVICES GREEN POLYCART

Brush and Bulk

Brush and bulk items (up to 3 cubic yards or 30 bags of leaves) are collected **THE THIRD FRIDAY OF EACH MONTH**. Brush must be cut to 4-foot lengths and tied in bundles. Furniture, boxes and other household items too big to fit inside your container, and construction debris (generated from your house only) will also be collected. Non-compactables like brick, concrete, dirt, composition shingles, etc. must be placed in containers. Containers and bundles must not weigh more than 50 pounds..

On-call Fee Service

For special request of brush and bulk collection, please call 817.317.2000.

When should I set my containers out and when should I retrieve them?

Please leave your old container at the curb until removed. We will begin removal after your service day on May 22. Be sure your recycling and waste containers are set out for collection by 7 a.m. FRIDAY for service each week and remove carts from street after service. Republic Services will begin delivering containers the week of May 18 until all new containers have been delivered.

Container Placement

Place your recycling and waste containers two feet away from each other and away from the edge of the street. Make sure the handle is facing your house, so that the lid opens toward the street. Please check to see that they are not obstructed by parked cars, boats, etc.

More Information

Landfill Usage

Residents will continue to utilize the DFW Landfill until September 30 and will begin using the Camelot Landfill at 550 Huffines Blvd., Lewisville up to 12 times per year effective October 1. Residents must bring proof of residency and a valid issued identification with matching addresses to gain access at no charge.

Household Hazardous Waste/E-Waste Events

These annual events are for proper disposal of household hazardous waste, electronics, tire disposal (up to 4 tires per address) and document shredding. The At-Your-Door service is no longer available to residents. Details about these events will be coming soon.
